A summary of benefits and coverage, known as an SBC, is a document that shows deductible and copay information as well as everything that is covered under Ascension Personalized Care. You can use the SBC as a reference tool to understand what your plan covers, as well as compare different plans to know what's right for you.

An SBC is an important document that shows how you and your plan would share the cost for covered health care services:

- It lists common medical situations and gives details on what's covered
- Limitations of coverage
- In-network vs. out-of-network specifications
- Provides details on what services your plan generally does not cover
